**REGISTRATION:** Online registration will open April 2<sup>nd</sup>. Walk-in registration will be held April 7<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> at the Lighthouse Christian Fellowship Church from 1 – 3:00 PM. Representatives will be on hand to answer questions and provide any additional information needed.

PSA Football will once again participate in the McKinney Youth Football League. Teams will be formed based on grades and not ages. All coaches must complete an application, pass a background check, and then be approved by the PSA. New teams can be formed by approved coaches. Players can be selected by coaches to play on their teams. Players have a guaranteed spot on the roster of the team they played for the previous season, though they are not required to return to a team. A player may leave a team for any reason. A player draft will be conducted to fill open roster spots for players not assigned to a team. Practices will begin at the end of July or early August, and games will begin in early September.
