REGISTRATION: Online registration remains open for flag football. To access the registration, click on the Registration link on the PSA Football page. The cost for Flag Football registration is \$65.00.

Kindergarten and 1st grade players will participate in an All-Prosper league. All games will be played at the PHS football stadium Saturday mornings.

All other age divisions will once again participate in the McKinney Youth Football League. Flag football is offered for 2nd through 6th grade, and tackle football is offered for 3rd through 6th grade. All divisions are based on school grade and not age. All coaches must complete an application, pass a background check, and then be approved by the PSA. Practices will begin in August, and games will begin in early September.
